

How to Post a Video To The Errol Flynn Blog



To post a video to **The Errol Flynn Blog**, you need to have the source code for the video which looks like this (from YouTube): we're using Robert Florczak's code for his video "GOTHIC."

On the **Post Article Page** set your article title, and any introductory text within the posting window that you'd like:

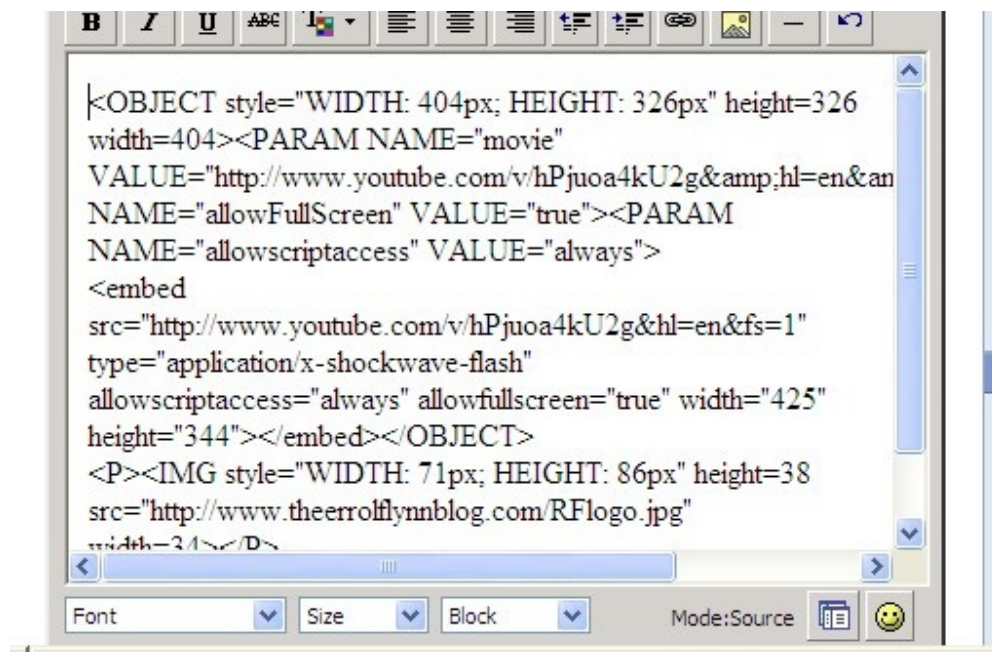
Next, go to the bottom of the Post Article window and find the **Mode: Display Button**:



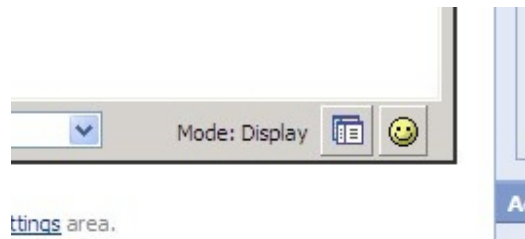
Click it, to switch to Mode: **Source**:



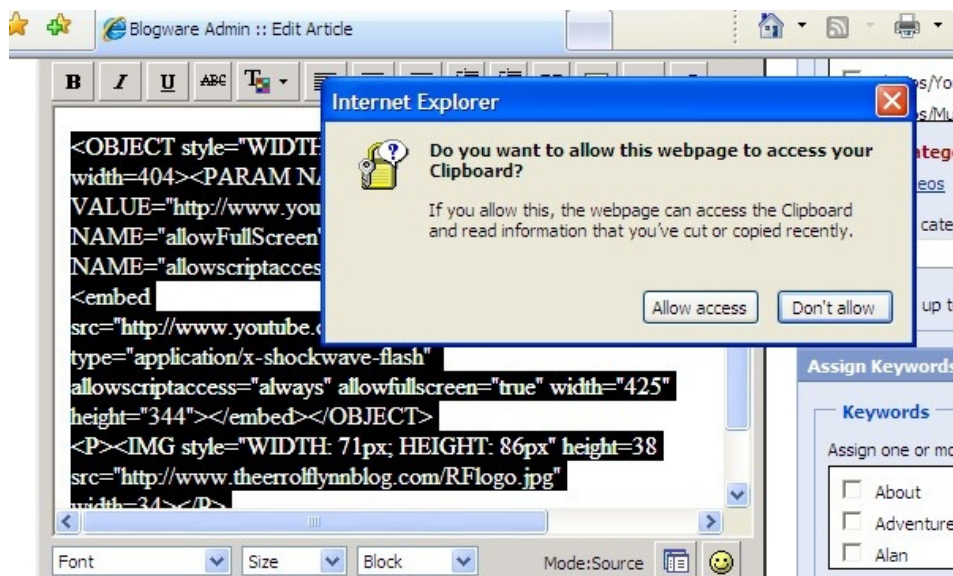
Now paste in the code from YouTube or whatever other source you are using for your video into the Post Article window:



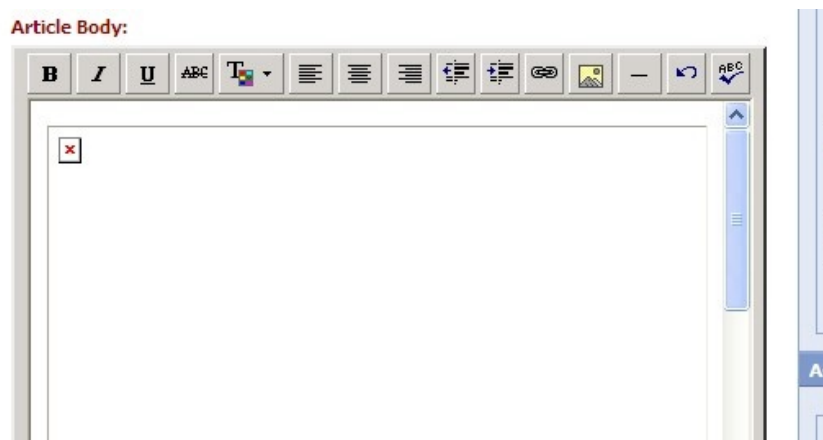
Now switch back to Mode: **Display**:



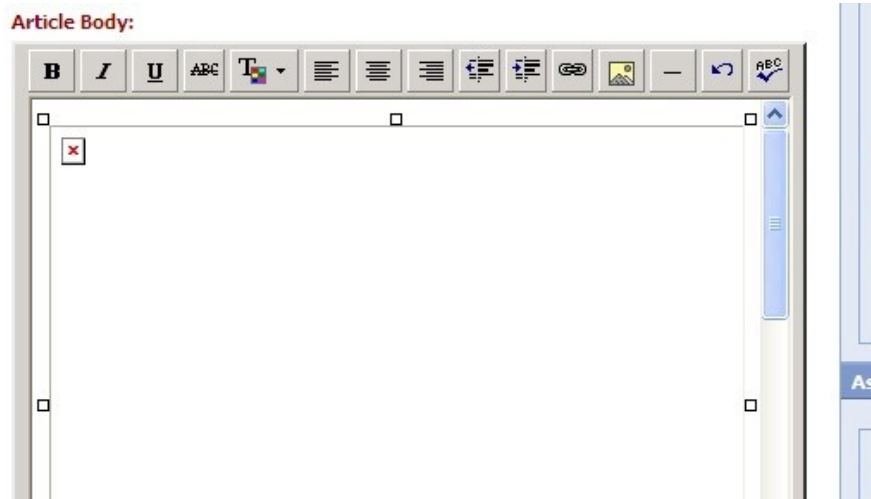
You will see this warning. Click **Allow Access**.



You may see a **RED X** instead of the video player. Ignore this for now. Drag the corners of your video within the Article Body window.

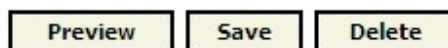


Click anywhere within the image to bring up the corner sliders, and drag toward the lower right hand corner of the posting window to resize the image. Make sure there is no white space underneath the image by using the blue slider at the side of the window to reveal the bottom of the image and then place the cursor in the empty space and hit backspace until the white area under the image is eliminated.



Use the **Preview Button** to view the way your posting will be seen on the blog:

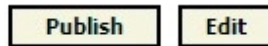

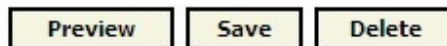

If you are happy with the way things look, click **Publish**, if not click **Edit** to return to the Post Article window to make edits. Do not use the back Button or you could lose your work!



On the Post Article window, click **Save** to publish your edited article with its text and video and then click View Blog to see the results.

Notes:

Sometimes when you click the Edit button on the Preview Page and go back to the Post Article window to make changes, the image that was nothing but a Red X will be revealed. It is a quirk of the blogware. Don't worry if it isn't revealed. If you saw it on the Preview Page it is there and will be published.

If you **View Blog**, and don't like something, you can click the little page icon at the left of the article title to go to the page where this article is "printed" on the blog:



This gives you access to an **edit entry** button at the far right hand corner of the top of the blog inside the blog's header:



Click **edit entry** to return to the Post Article window for the article you just posted, or any article you posted and now want to re-edit. It's a handy way to get directly to the article you want to read or to edit on the blog...

Sometimes, a bit of code will not work on the blog. Very frustrating! If you have a video that you want to use but no player you can use the player code for another video (in the same format) by cut and pasting the source of the video into the code for a player that works:

All you do is change the location of the movie file in the code for the player. Below you see in bold the location of the movie file for Gothic and all that is needed is to substitute the web address of your movie file for the one that is in bold print. Save and upload!
